We are the only cruise operation that commences each upstream journey from Saigon Port, which can be access in less than 15 minutes by coach from central hotels.

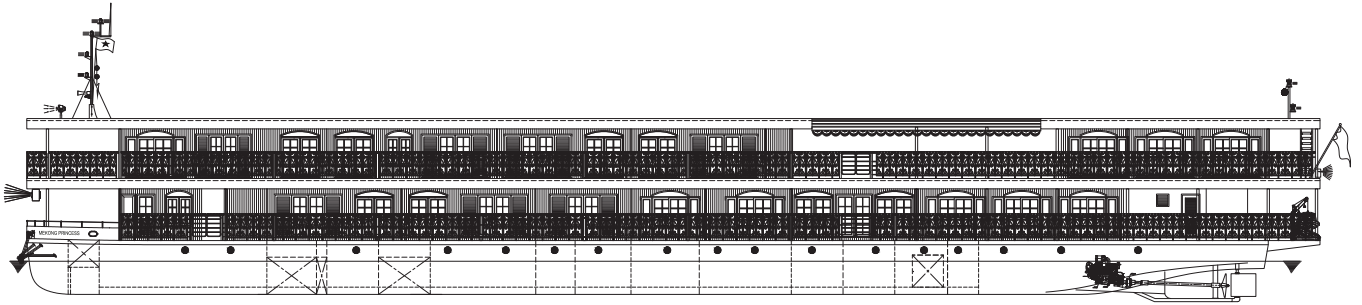
Through its unique engineering design and construction, Mekong Princess cruises with minimum engine noise and virtually no vibration and is incredibly stable in all weather and sea-state conditions.

We place much emphasis on safety. An independent specialist Singaporean based operation certifies our vessel, and provide regular ongoing safety training to all sailors and service crew. Throughout the vessel, international quality safety equipment is positioned at key locations to meet every IMO (International Maritime Organization) safety drill. We boast a 100% safety record. All Viet Princess vessels are survey approved by the national Shipping Registry VIRES (Vietnam Register).

Viet Princess Cruises is the proud developer of three luxurious and innovative cruise vessels.

Each of our modern steel hulled ships is handfinished in brass and teak and constructed by highly skilled ship building craftsmen. By philosophy, concept and style, we consistently embrace the classic 'French Colonial Era' in all fixtures and fittings. Our fleet is designed with ultra-shallow drafts, which enables us to navigate in extremely remote areas and shallow waterways. We focus on providing the highest standards of service with ongoing international hospitality training.

Safety is our number one priority at all times. We comply with international safety standards by design and construction and conduct regular safety training programs.

Built in Saigon to international design and safety standards, Mekong Princess was launched in 2015 and is considered the best constructed and most elegant vessel plying the waters of the Mekong River today. The Mekong Princess is 63 meters in length with a 10 meter beam (width). She is powered by two 480 HP Doosan Marine engines and can cruise at a top speed of eleven knots (20 kms per hour). The average cruising speed is 8 knots (approximately 15 kms per hour). Built in Saigon to international design and safety standards.

SAFETY & SECURITY

The Mekong Princess is built to international safety standards and surveyed by the national shipping registry organization VIRES.

All twenty-seven crew undertake regular safety drills. These monthly practical training sessions comply with international safety standards as specified by the IMO (International Maritime Organization).

Throughout the vessel is a variety of safety equipment that meets international SOLAS standards. These include a ratio of two lifejackets per person onboard. There are SOLAS (Safety Of Life At Sea) approved life rafts and PCCC assessed fire-fighting equipment located at strategic locations.

- ▶ All onboard crew is trained and certified as per international marine standards (VIRES).
- ▶ Fire alarm system in all cabins, public areas and below deck areas.

The Itinerary

DAY 01 SAIGON PORT - EMBARKATION



Our guide awaits you at the Meeting Point, Park Hyatt Saigon, then transfer to the Mekong Princess docking at Saigon Port. Once aboard, you will be welcomed by your Vietnamese and Cambodian ship's crew, before embarking on the most extraordinary journey of discovery. We sail at midday through the famed Mekong Delta on our way to the 'Mighty Mekong River'.

Lunch, with highly attentive oriental hospitality, will be served soon after departure, as we cruise along the Saigon River. Having settled into your luxurious suites, you can relax and enjoy the new scenes and watch the world pass by.

Late in the day we anchor in the heart of the Mekong Delta, where cocktails are served as sun sets, and sampans pass by. A traditional Vietnamese dinner is soon ready, embracing a subtle fusion of dishes for the most eclectic tastes.

DAY 02 BEN TRE, TIEN LOI ISLAND

For early risers, sunrise tea or coffee provides the perfect start to your day.

Today, you witness the hustle and bustle of delta river life as the local traders take their produce to market. After breakfast, we board the classically built sampans to explore the narrow canals and backwaters of this famed region.

Cruising amidst the mangroves and Nipah Palm plantations, we will disembark to visit the handcrafted coconut candy-makers. This is a famous cottage industry and a local delicacy, enjoyed throughout Vietnam and Southeast Asia. Upon ship's arrival in Ben Tre, meet your guide and sampan driver, we head to Tien Loi island. Tien Loi island is untouched by tourist activity. You will be amazed by honest welcome from rustic locals.

Arrive Tien Loi island, just a few steps from pier, you will see a big fish pond fed by a local family for selling, then take a short walk to

a local family and learn how to manually weave mat and make chicken coops. Take a seat chatting with host and enjoying tropical fruits with tea.

Another few minute walk to other family making hats & baskets from sedge. You have chance buying their products at whole sale rates. Then, walk to pier for sampan driving through a canal to the ship.

DAY 03 CAN THO, HOA AN

We begin our morning before breakfast aboard the sampans for a cruise through the fascinating Cai Rang floating market near Can Tho. The sampans will weave in and out of the many boats that sail into the market each morning to sell produce and other items the residents of the Mekong Delta need in their daily lives. As they weave through the market, there will be many opportunities for amazing photographs, while enjoying fresh fruit and the Vietnamese "anti-aging drink," fresh coconut water. Before returning to the ship

for breakfast, we stop at a local noodle factory, where we witness the amazing process of how they are made.

After lunch, continue excursion by boat to Hoa An village, where is untouched and well-known with flower growing and handmade craft. Our first stop at flower gardens where we will see many different kinds of flowers and learn how to grow and take care of them. Then, a short walking to a local house and chat with the host to see how they live and work in their daily life.

After a short break, continue our excursion on motor cart to another village. We stop by at the conical hat-making and mat weaving families, have memorable time chatting with local family members and learning how to create products though hands-on experience. Enjoy your walk in the peaceful village with rice fields, fruit trees...in between visiting 2 local families. Then, we say goodbye and go back to the ship by boat.

DAY 04 GIENG ISLAND

This morning we board sampans that will take us into Gieng Island. After a short walk around the local sampan village, where hundreds of sampans are produced daily by local families, we take a canal drive to explore the untouched floating area with duck farms, monkey bridges, and tropical orchards along the riverside. We will try one of most popular local transportation named “xe loi” (motor trishaw) driving through this island to visit a Catholic Church, built around the same time as the Notre Dame Cathedral in Saigon in the 1870s.

DAY 05 HONG NGU, BORDER CROSSING

Today we visit the local island village of Hong Ngu, not far from the Vietnam-Cambodia border. Hong Ngu produces a large number of the traditional, Khmer scarves exported to Cambodia. Woven in many homes around the village, here we have the opportunity to see the weaving process under several homes. Some villagers are also embroidery artists, displaying their art in and around the homes. The inhabitants of this area had only encountered one western visitor prior to the arrival of the Mekong Princess, they are especially friendly and welcoming. Guests will also visit the local temple dedicated to a unique religion founded in this area of Vietnam, Hoa Hao. This afternoon, the Mekong Princess will cross the border into Cambodia and continue up the Mekong River.

DAY 07 ANGKOR BAN

Today we start the day with a visit to the charming town of Angkor Ban. Here, we witness the daily life of the local people, starting with a visit to a family’s home, to meet the family and discuss their lifestyle. We continue through the village to the local school where we join the children in their classroom and experience what their typical school day is like.

DAY 06 PHNOM PENH & WELCOME TO CAMBODIA

After breakfast this morning, local cyclo drivers meet you for an exciting city tour of Phnom Penh. You begin your ride along the riverfront to the Royal Palace, where a leisurely walk takes you through the grounds, with opportunities to visit the Throne Hall and Moonlight Pavilion. Upon crossing into the second section of the complex, you walk amongst enormous stupas and spirit houses, on the way to the famous Silver Pagoda, home of Cambodia’s Emerald Buddha and Maitreya Buddha, encrusted with more than 9,000 diamonds. Following a short break, your cyclos take you to the National Museum. Housing the largest pre-Angkorian and Angkorian holdings in Cambodia, the National Museum ends the morning tour with a comprehensive look at many of the artifacts excavated around the Angkor Archeological Area in Siem Reap, as well as other areas around the former Khmer Empire. After a return cyclo ride to the ship, you may wish to take some time to have lunch at a local restaurant, walk along the quay, or visit some of Phnom Penh’s famous markets and lovely boutiques.

This afternoon, private motor-coach take you on a scenic 45-minute drive from the ship, arriving at Choeung Ek, the killing fields depicted in the movie, and the center of the darkest days of Cambodian history. You may walk through the fields, visit the small museum and Memorial Stupa, and learn more about the atrocities committed during the Khmer Rouge regime. On the return drive to Phnom Penh, a stop is made at Tuol Sleng (infamously known as S-21), which was converted by the Khmer Rouge from a large school to a prison and torture headquarters.

Before dinner, children from a local orphanage entertain guests with a cultural performance including Apsara, Cambodia’s national dance, as well as several traditional folk dances.



DAY 08 KAMPONG CHAM, DISEMBARKATION

After breakfast we disembark the Mekong Princess in Kampong Cham. Transfer by motor-coach to Siem Reap. Arrive Meeting Point at the Park Hyatt Siem Reap Hotel at noon.

Viet Princess Cruises reserves the right to cancel, alter, advance, postpone or substitute any scheduled sailing or itinerary, substitute another vessel for the scheduled ship, or substitute or cancel scheduled ports of call, which, in its sole judgment and discretion, is justified for any reason, and to do so without liability for any loss whatsoever to guests as a result of said change(s). Additionally, Viet Princess Cruises reserves the right to cancel reservations and bookings in the event of a full-ship charter, whether or not a deposit or full payment has been received, and in such event, Viet Princess Cruises's only liability will be to refund to the guest the amount it has received. Viet Princess Cruises makes arrangements for transportation, other than cruise passage, only as a booking agent. Viet Princess Cruises's responsibility does not extend beyond the vessel. In arranging for the transportation of guests to and from the ship, Viet Princess Cruises does so with independent contractors. Viet Princess Cruises is

not responsible for incidents such as airline cancellations, re-routings or any disruption of scheduled services or accommodation, or lost luggage. All fares indicated in this brochure including land and hotel, are capacity controlled, subject to change at anytime without notice and do not guarantee availability. All are subject to change and/or cancellation without notice. Travel documents will not be dispatched until full and final payment and passenger Contact Information has been received by Viet Princess Cruises and cleared. CRUISE TARIFF

HEALTH AND MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS

All guests are required to report in writing to Viet Princess Cruises at the time their reservation is made:

- Any physical or mental condition that may require medical or professional treatment or attention during the voyage
- Any condition that may render the guest unfit for travel, or that may require special care or assistance
- Any condition that may pose a risk or danger to the guest or anyone else onboard the ship

BAGGAGE

You may bring aboard the ship a reasonable amount of clothing and personal effects without charge. Baggage for Viet Princess Cruises guests or guests on our land extension programs must be handled in accordance with regulations of our ground operators. Baggage exceeding these limitations is subject to the charges as set forth by the individual operators. Airlines are strict with baggage limitations. Guests are encouraged to contact individual airlines for weight limitations. All baggage must be securely packed, and properly and clearly labeled. Liquid, fragile, perishable and other articles not suitably packed are transported at your own risk. Viet Princess Cruises is not responsible for loss or damage to baggage or any other personal item during air travel or land extension programs. Baggage and personal belongings will be taken off the ship upon guest disembarkation. Under no circumstances will baggage be stored onboard without the owner of such baggage being on the vessel. Viet Princess Cruises is not responsible for baggage stored in shore side facilities. Under no circumstances may dangerous items (including but not limited to: explosives, firearms, combustible or illegal substances) be taken aboard the ship. We recommend that you hand-carry travel documents (passport, visa, cruise tickets), medications and valuables. These items are the full responsibility of the guest at all times. Viet Princess Cruises shall not be responsible for the loss of, or damage to, such personal items.

LOST PROPERTY

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS
